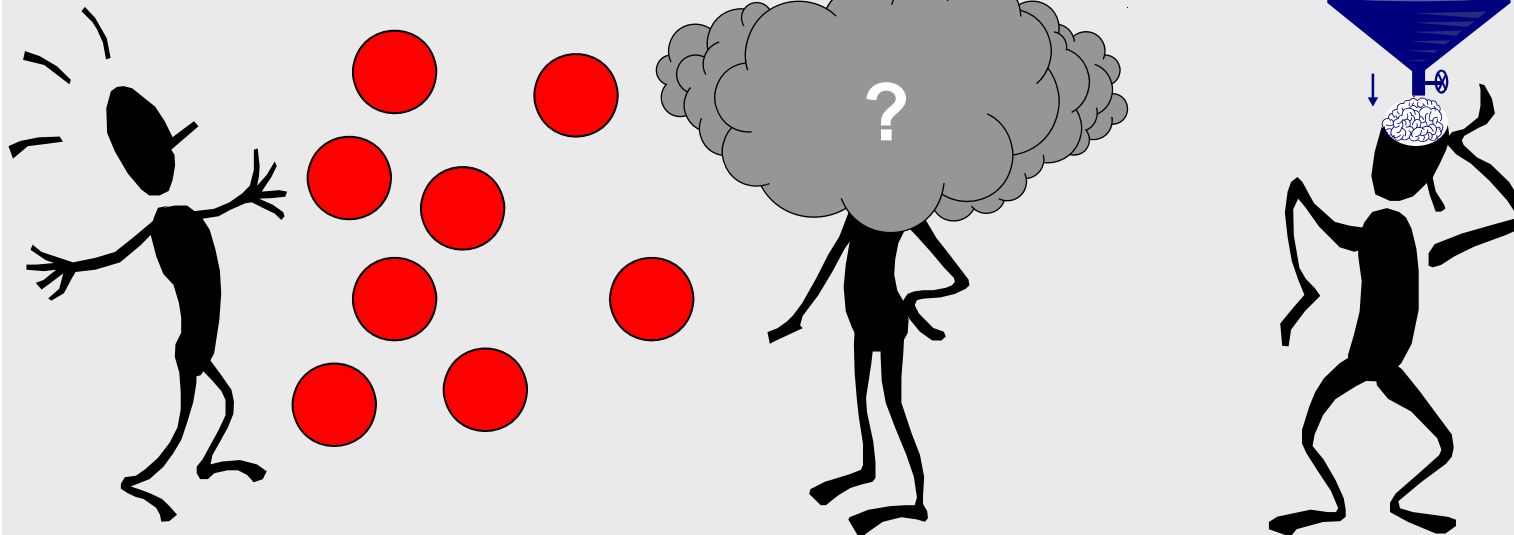

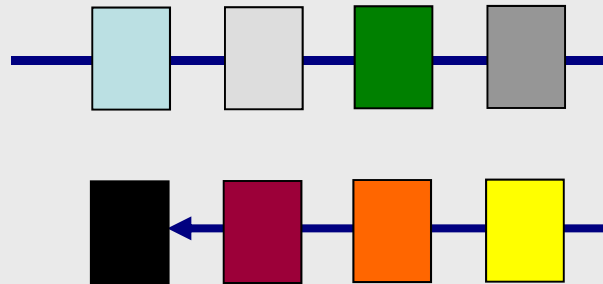

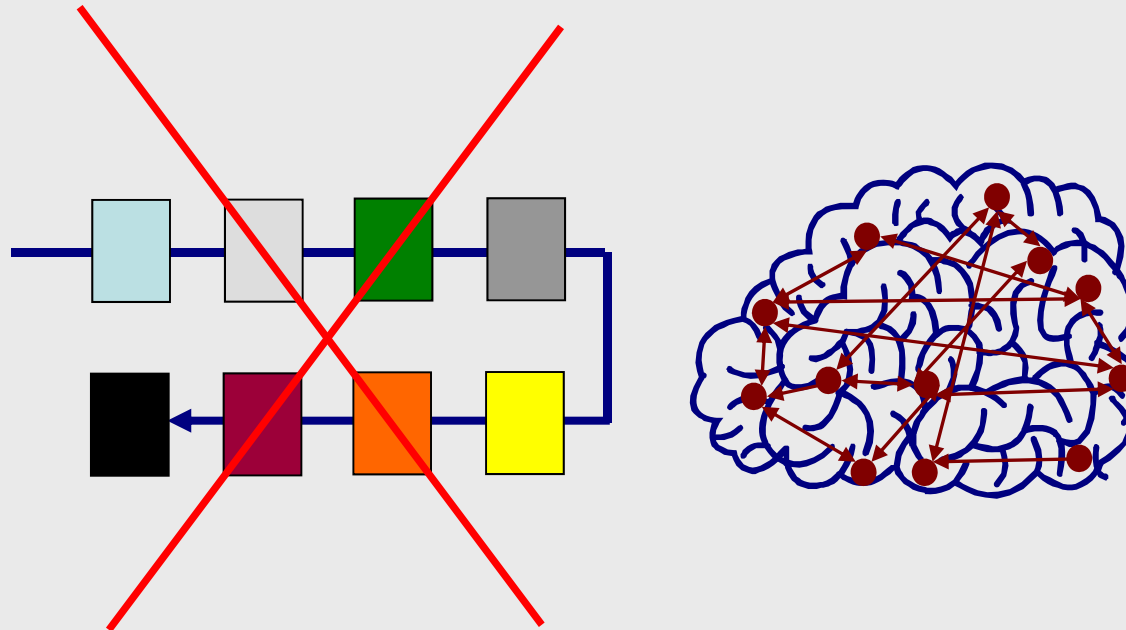
New approach by Semantic: Structuring of Information



Usable for many cases! ne!

- Which colleague is occupied in which way with topic A?
- What else do I have to consider concerning topic A?
- How do I solve this problem?
- Which relationship exists between method X and method Y?

New approach by Semantic: The Human Factor in the focus

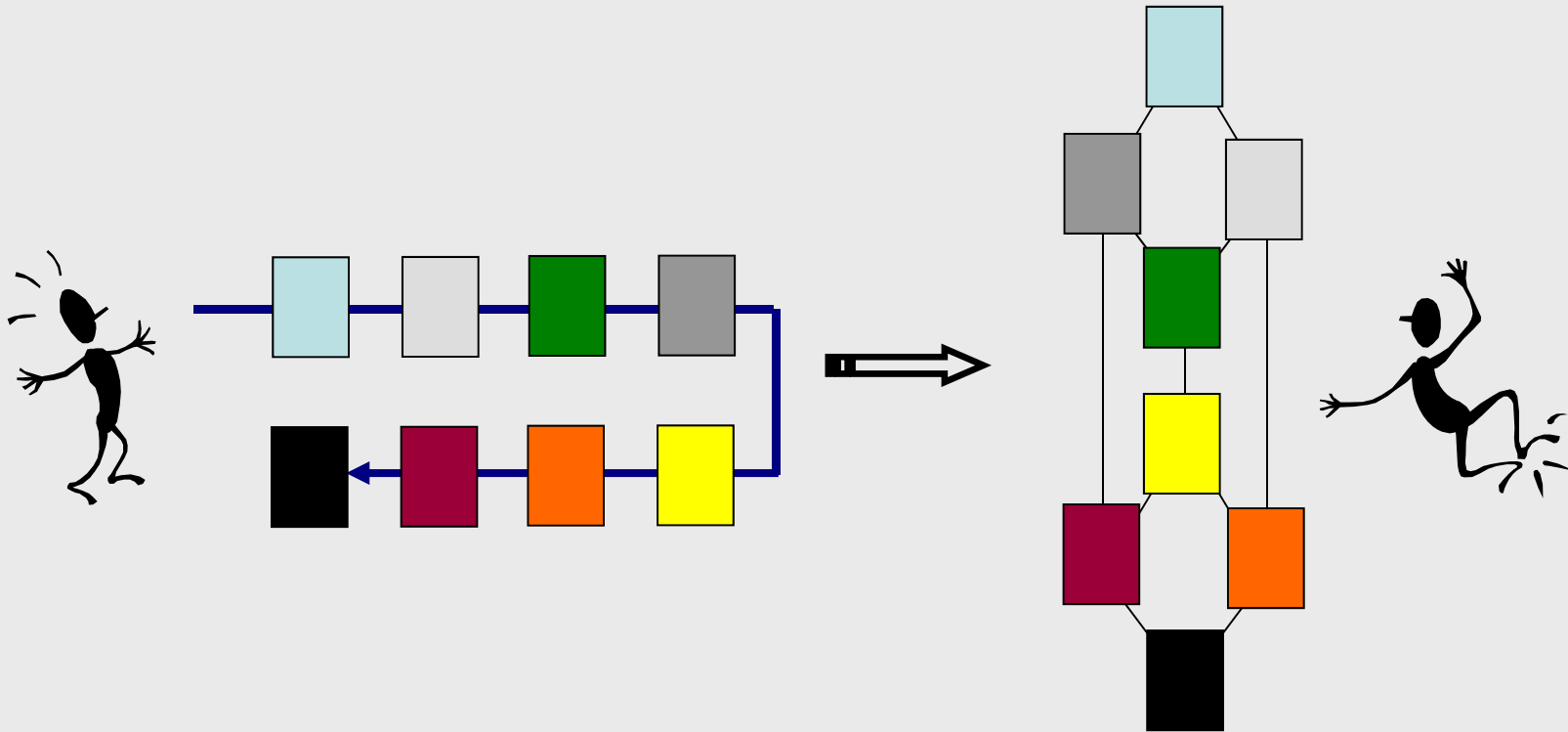


- Learners don't think in hierarchical but contextual way

- Information should be offered in context

➡ No helpful support in Information- and Learning processes by linear structured content

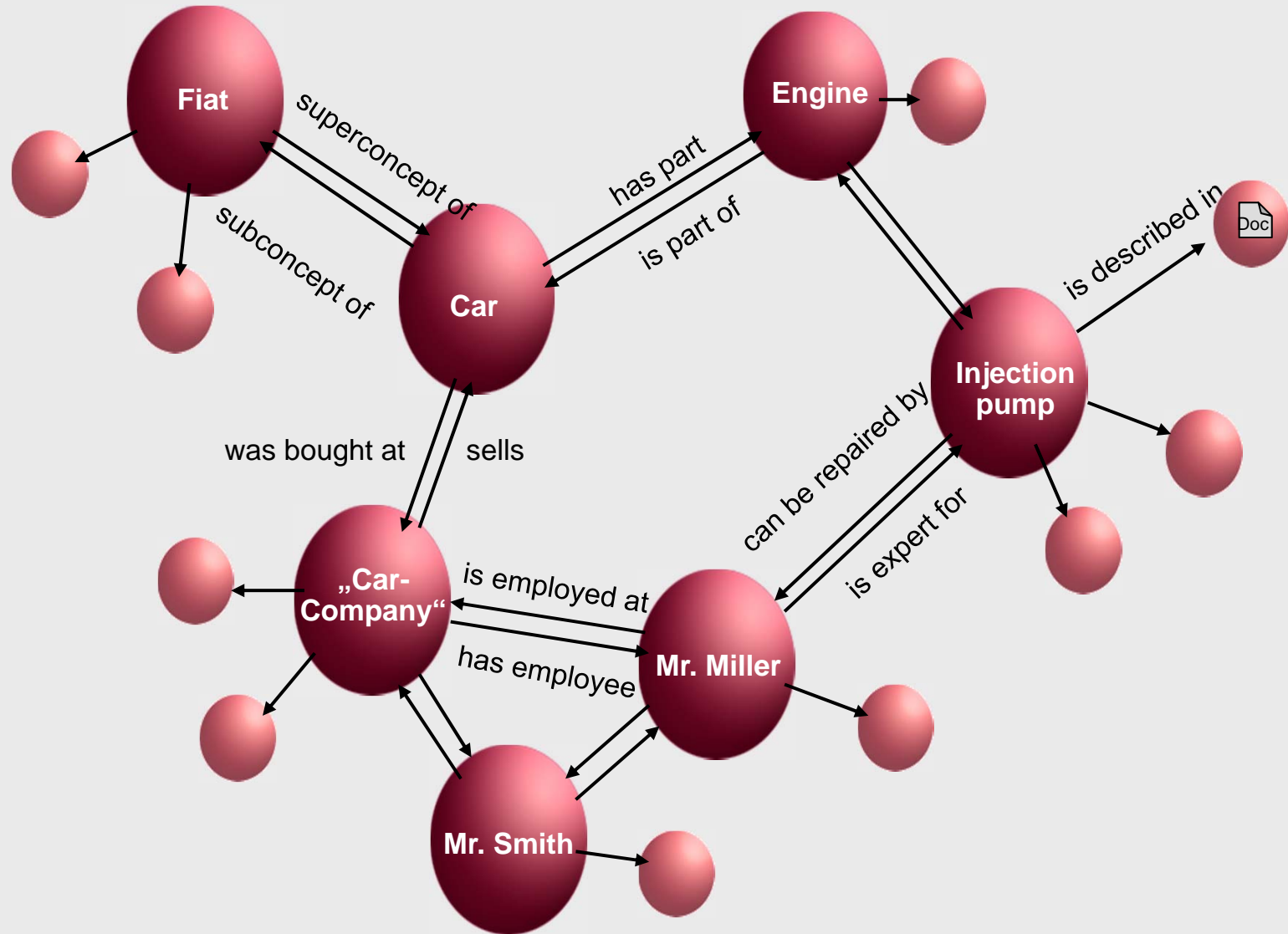
New approach by Semantic: „Content in context“



Linear-oriented, isolated Structure Context-oriented Structure

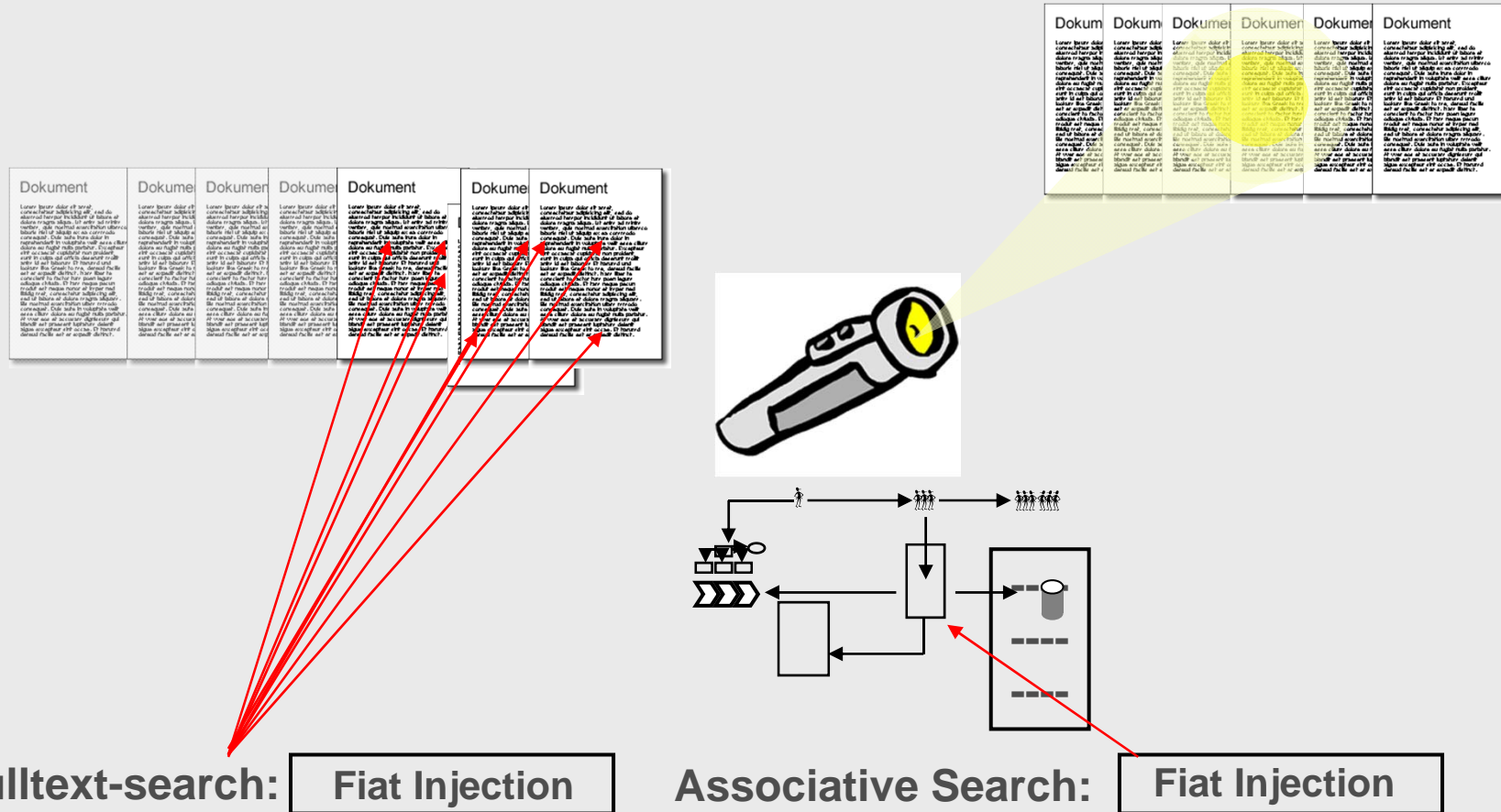
➔ „Semantic Datamodel“

New approach by Semantics: Higher Quality of Search Results (1/3)



Fulltext-search: **Fiat Injection**

Associative Search: **Fiat Injection**

Google finds 161.000 Entries!



New approach by Semantics: Higher Quality of Search Results (2/3)

Search for „Fiat Injection“ delivers als results:

- Injection pumps can be repaired at the „CarCompany“
- The „CarCompany“ has an expert for injection pumps
- The file „repair.doc“ describes the repair of the pump
- ...

No Fulltext-search!

New approach by Semantics: Higher Quality of Search Results (3/3)

Search by „Google“

many Documents

results by Fulltext-search

time-intensively, not exakt

isolated Information

Search by Semantik

less, but helpful Documents

results by topic

quick and exakt

Information in context



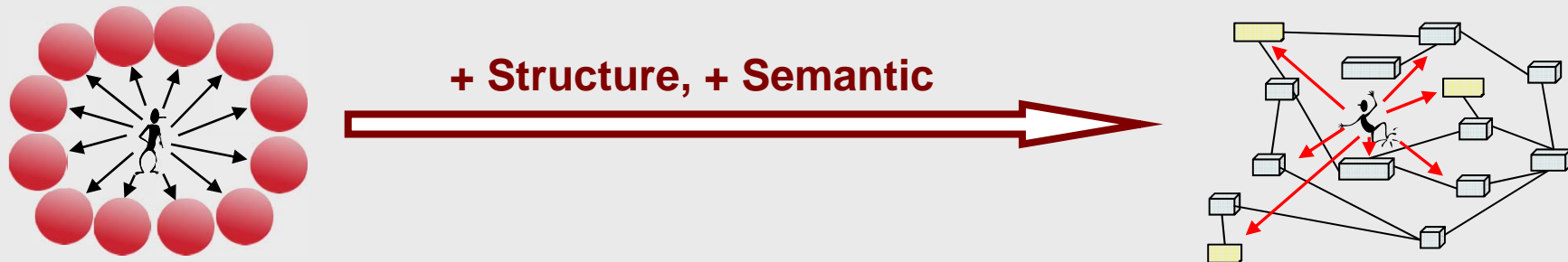
Semantic technology leads to a new quality of search

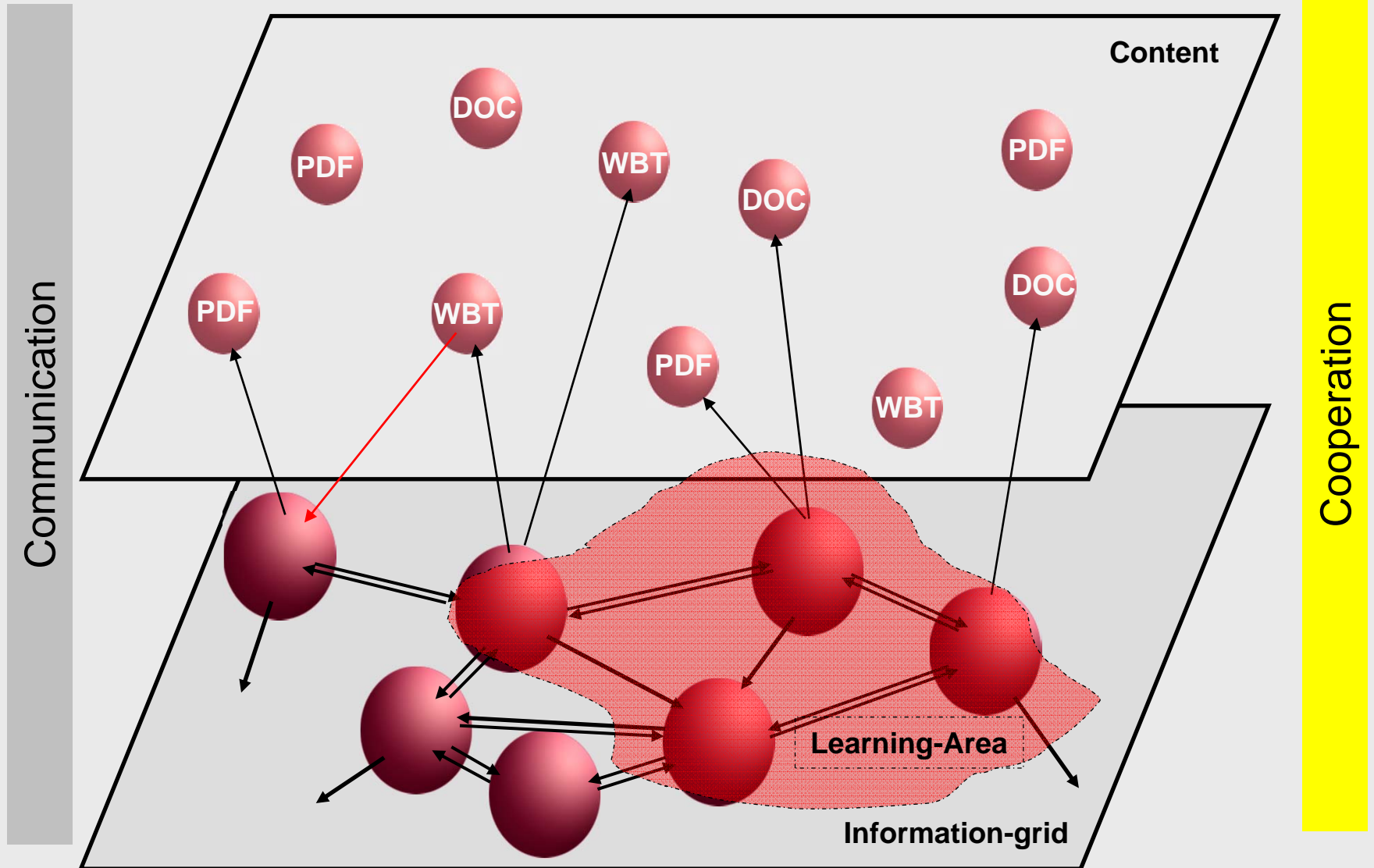

Current project: Challenges

- Often no competence for self-learning
- New possibilities to navigate require new concepts to do so
- Expenditure of time for describing semantics

- Promotion of exploring and self-controlled learning

Conclusion
